## Freeport & YPMAK Provide PPE and Financial Support for the Prevention of COVID-19 in Timika

TIMIKA - PT Freeport Indonesia and the Amungme Kamoro Community Empowerment Foundation (YPMAK) handed over personal protective equipment (PPE) assistance to the Mimika Regency Government, through the Covid-19 Prevention Acceleration Prevention Task Force Team in Mimika District.

The handed-over was held at the Timika MPCC Building on Monday (30/3) by the Director of YPMAK, Vebian Magal with PTFI's Community Health Development (CHD) Manager, Govert Waramori, and received by the Acting Head of the Mimika District Health Office, Reynold Ubra.

The aid includes 50 sets of PPE in the form of bio hazard clothing, 50 units of mist blower spraying machines used for spraying disinfectant liquids for indoor and outdoor areas, as well as 500 liters of disinfectant fluids. PTFI and YPMAK assistance was provided in the form of equipment needed for the preventive and handling measures of the spread Covid-19 in Timika. "Value of the assistance reaches a total of around 5 billion rupiah," said Vebian Magal.

PTFI and YPMAK are collaborating with the Mimika Regency Government through the Health Office, together with the Covid-19 Task Force for the Acceleration of Prevention in Timika in distributing the aid, so that it can be optimally used. "PT Freport Indonesia supports the prevention efforts of the spread of Covid 19 in Mimika Regency. In collaboration with the Mimika Regency Government, PTFI submits this PPE assistance to be used by medical personnel when handling patients," said Govert Waramori, representing PTFI Management.

Previously, PTFI had carried out efforts to prevent the spread of Covid-19 by implementing Social Distancing in the work area, as well as carrying out travel restrictions for employees and communities in the company
