Freeport & Mimika Regency Government World Environment Day Commemoration Climaxes

Timika, 5 July 2024 – On Friday (5/7), PT Freeport Indonesia (PTFI) in collaboration with Mimika Regency Environment Office held an event that was the climax of their World Environment Day 2024 commemoration, at the Gedung Eme Neme Yauware hall in Timika.

"Today commemoration of World Environment Day 2024, which is a collaboration between PTFI and Mimika Regency Environment Office comes to a climax. Earlier Freeport held a series of activities to celebrate World Environment Day, beginning on 15 May with a planting action in the Grasberg area, followed by environment-related workshops, contests and competitions, an urban clean-up drive, and release of wildlife into their natural environment," PTFI Environmental Vice President Gesang Setyadi conveyed.
